From Barbara . . .

How much do we have to suffer for our faith? Our faith is what saves us and is what gives us the strength to endure the suffering no matter what comes our way. We have to remember that God does not give us the suffering. God loves us always. God strengthens us and guards us from evil. Some of us think that if we doubt, our faith is not strong. Our doubts help us to clarify our faith. I recently heard a Presbyterian minister say that the opposite of faith is not doubt but certainty. If we are certain we do not need faith and there is no further need to explore. Sometimes our certainty makes it difficult to be faithful. The love of God gives us the strength and courage to work through the doubts and to let our faith lead us. Take time this week to explore a doubt that you have. Pray about it, ask God for guidance, read what the church teaches, consult the scriptures, talk to someone you trust about it, wrestle with it in your heart and then resolve the doubt or live with it. Remember, God loves us always.

Our youth ministry is preparing to participate in a workcamp next summer. At this workcamp they will be painting, repairing, gardening, and performing many other tasks for people in Winchester, VA who are unable to do these things for themselves. They will be with approximately 200 other young people all doing the same thing. There are many ways we as a parish can support and help them. Please pray for them and keep watching the bulletin for how you can help.
