Lenten Observances of Fast and Abstinence

In the U.S. in accord with the Provisions of the Code of Canon Law and the decision of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, **Ash Wednesday, February 17** and **Good Friday, April 2**, are days of **Fast and Abstinence**. All **Fridays** in Lent are days of Abstinence. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics over the age of 14. The obligation to fast, limits oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of the day, binds adults between the age of 18 - 60.
